ENROLLMENT PROCESS:

1. Read the Student Handbook.

2. Completely fill out all paperwork.

3. Return all paperwork and the \$160 per student Enrollment and Insurance Fee to the school office.

4. Testing: Students entering grades 1 through 12 will be scheduled for entrance testing. These tests assist in the placement of the student academically.

5. High School students must provide an official transcript of their grades.

6. Interview: Parents and student(s) will be interviewed by the principal for their grade level. Victory Life Academy reserves the right to schedule an interview with a pastor should this be deemed necessary.

NOTE: No student will be considered enrolled without completing the above enrollment process. Should it be determined by the administration that Victory Life Academy is not able to meet the educational needs of the student and is not able to enroll him/her, the enrollment fee(s) will be refunded in full. Otherwise, all enrollment fees are non-refundable.

** **Book Fees** for Seniors are based on the number of classes they are enrolled in at \$65/class so this amount could vary depending on courses taken.

SMART Fee: \$43 yearly per family.
Books & Supplies Fees, Lab Fees Activity Fees and Tuition are payable in 12 monthly installments (June-May) through the SMART Tuition Management Program. In the event of a late payment, there will be a \$45 late fee applied to your account.

ADDITIONAL COSTS IF NEEDED:

Home School Achievement Test Fee: \$25 per child

Cafeteria: Breakfast: K-5 – 12th - \$1.50 / Includes Milk or Juice

Lunch: K-5 – 5th Grade - \$2.50 daily / Hotplate lunch price includes drink.

6th – 12th Grade - \$3.00 daily / Hotplate lunch price includes drink.

[Applications for the *Reduced Lunch Program* may be obtained from the School Office.]

Extended Care: For students needing after school care until 6:00 p.m. Offered by VLA's Child Development Center
Registration packets are available from the CDC office.

Cost: \$30.00 a week or \$4.00 per hour for drop-in-students.

Bus Fee: A bus route is available to students needing transportation from the Denison and Colbert areas.

Fees are payable through SMART Tuition Management Program.

Denison

\$600/yr - 1st child

\$500/yr - each additional family member

Colbert

\$500/yr - 1st child

\$400/yr - each additional family member

Fee for non-enrolled students: \$4.00 one way.

Note: Bus routes from other areas will be considered with a minimum of 15 students.

Fuel Surcharge: May be applied if price of fuel dictates the necessity.

Payment Discounts: 2% Discount if paid in full at the first of the school year.

1% Discount if paid in full per semester at the beginning of the semester.

Multiple Children Discount:

1st & 2nd Children = Full Cost 3rd Child = 5% Discount 4th Child = 15% Discount 5th Child = 25% Discount

Returned Check Fee: A fine of \$25.00 will be charged for returned checks.

Late Fee: Delinquency on outstanding balances for tuition, bus fees, fundraiser amounts due, cafeteria bills, library fees, etc. may be subject to a late fee of \$25 if not brought current within 30 days.
